IN CASE OF EMERGENCY- in the unlikely event that we need to empty the church in an emergency please make sure you are aware of the fire escape routes. MESSAGE FROM ST HILDA'S: 'We are looking for a household who could offer a Nigerian lady, who is a refused asylum seeker, a furnished bedroom, the use of their kitchen (for cooking, clothes washing etc), fridge / freezer space to store food, use of the bathroom and wi-fi. Mercy, aged 39, is a Christian and would wish to be where she can attend a Church regularly. She is currently doing an Access to Higher Education Course at University College Birmingham which continues until December, so needs to be able to get online easily for lectures / submissions etc. She has her own computer.

There are hidden costs to a host (e.g. electricity, gas, hot water), but her basic personal needs. such as food, bus fares etc. can continue to be covered by members of St.Hilda's Church, Warley Woods. The arrangement would be from early September until the end of December. (By the end of the year, if no grounds can be found for a new asylum claim, she will have to either agree to return to Nigeria, or appeal to the Red Cross for help.) OPENING UP WITH THE PANDEMIC - As always, we will be following the guidance of bishop's conference as we move forward in the coming months. We have been asked to be cautious in the coming weeks as the country comes to terms with the opening of restrictions. For the time being there will be little change to how we gather and celebrate mass. If anybody has any views on how we move forward, please let Fr Roger know.
