SCRIPTURAL REFLECTION: *Lord may my ears, hear and my eyes, see*
By the time of Jesus many religious traditions were in place which served to differentiate between those who were on the inside and those who were outsiders. This led to divisions, inequality, and oppression — the very things that the covenant was supposed to eradicate. So, when Jesus reached out to the poor, to sinners and those on the margins he was bringing into focus once again the kind of world God wanted. His was a love that included everyone, and which could not be bought. In commanding that the ears of the deaf man be opened there is a message to us all, especially those who think that their hearing is perfect. Our ability to really hear the good news can be limited by many things, especially closed minds, and hearts. Perhaps as individuals and as a community our prayer during this Sunday Eucharist might be that we are open to all the transformation that God wants to work in us.
