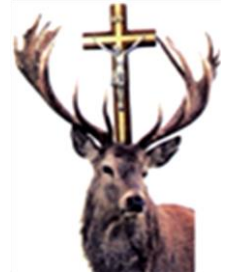

If we need to evacuate, please do not leave, but rather gather on the grass lawn at the side of the church.

SUNDAY 7TH NOVEMBER - Cardinal Vincent Nicholls has recently asked the Bishops of England and Wales to celebrate a Mass in their cathedrals on Sunday 7th November for those who have died during the pandemic and for all healthcare and frontline workers who have supported our local communities during the last eighteen

months. Archbishop Bernard be offering Mass in St Chad's Cathedral next Sunday at 11.30am. For this reason we also will be offering up a mass next weekend for this same intention next Saturday evening

1ST SUNDAY ROSARY - 7 NOVEMBER AFTER MASS - this month we shall be praying the Luminous mysteries.
