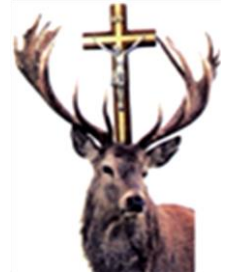

Fr Joseph Nwafor: 15 years of Priesthood. This Sunday from 12 noon English Martyrs church will be hosting a little celebration to mark Fr Joseph's 15th Anniversary of Ordination. If you know Fr Joseph and would like to wish him well and congratulate him I am sure you would be made most welcome at this gathering.

THE ANNUAL MASS FOR DECEASED CLERGY and members of the Dudley deanery will take place at **Our Lady and All Saints**, Stourbridge DY8 1PQ at 12.30 pm this Tuesday 9th November. **All are welcome (and encouraged!)** to attend. For this reason, there will be no mass at St Hubert's this Tuesday. This will actually be the last gathering of the Dudley deanery, since parishes are due to be absorbed into other deaneries as part of the Diocese Plan for the future, mentioned by Archbishop Bernard in his pastoral letters.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY - in the unlikely event that we need to empty the church in an emergency please make sure you are aware of the fire escape routes. One is located at the entrance door that you will have come through as you entered the church. The second is through the toilet corridor and conference room. If we need to

evacuate, please do not leave, but rather gather on the grass lawn at the side of the church.

OUR LADY AND ST HUBERT SCHOOL (GOVERNORS POSITIONS) - There are vacancies for foundation governors at the school from this term for anybody who may be interested, there are potentially 2 positions. If this is something that is of interest to you, please contact Fr Roger who will assist you in an application.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION - is available every Saturday from 5.30 pm before mass and by appointment with Fr Roger.

Cardinal Vincent Nicholls has recently asked the Bishops of England and Wales to celebrate a Mass in their cathedrals this Sunday, 7th November, for those who have died during the pandemic and for all healthcare and frontline workers who have supported our local communities during the last eighteen months. Archbishop Bernard will be offering Mass in St Chad's Cathedral this Sunday at 11.30am, for this intention. We will also be offering up a mass here at St Huberts for this same intention this Saturday evening (at the 6pm mass) and we shall be praying especially for this intention this weekend

1ST SUNDAY ROSARY - 7TH NOVEMBER AFTER MASS - this month we shall be praying the Luminous mysteries.
