Updated Coronavirus Guidance - from (10/12/21) government guidance states that once again the wearing of face coverings in places of worship is mandatory. After you have evacuated please do not leave the site but gather on the grass lawn beside the church.

Sacrament of Reconciliation - is available every Saturday morning immediately after the 10:00am mass and from 5.30 pm before the evening mass and by appointment with Fr Roger.
