Updated Coronavirus Guidance. The government guidance states that once again the wearing of face coverings in places of worship is mandatory. This applies to all people above the age of 12 unless they have a medical exemption. Please do not be offended if you are asked to wear one (we have some available, just ask one of the stewards).

Security of and within the church - the issue of security has unfortunately arisen, recently theft of several items has occurred. We are currently considering how we can improve the security of the church. Above all take care of your own property (handbags, phones etc.) always.

Sacramental Preparation for Young People not at Catholic Schools. We are coming to the time of year when preparation increases for the reception of 1st Holy Communion and confirmation for young people. 1st holy communion is available for those in year 3 and above, and year 6 for confirmation. Altar Servers. This important ministry is open to anyone who has made their First Holy Communion. It is not just for Children! If you are interested in becoming an altar server please let Deacon David know by email or in person: dcn.david.williams@rcaob.org.uk. There will be a period of training before you start.

Spiritual Communion Prayer. My Jesus, I believe that You are truly present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love you above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as being already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

In Case of Emergency - in the unlikely event that we need to empty the church in an emergency please make sure you are aware of the fire escape routes. One is located at the entrance door that you will have come through as you entered the church. The second is through the toilet corridor and conference room. After you have evacuated, please do not leave the site but gather on the grass lawn.

Sacrament of Reconciliation - is available every Saturday morning immediately after the 10:00am mass and from 5.30 pm before the evening mass and by appointment with Fr Roger.

Parish Census - If you would like to fill in a census form you will find them at the back of the church, they need to be handed to Ann Williams, our safeguarding officer, to comply with the general data protection rules (GDPR).

Going into Hospital - It is important that you notify the parish or ask to be referred to the relevant catholic chaplain, if you or a member of your family are admitted into hospital. If you ever find yourself in hospital and would like a visit from a Catholic Priest just ask a nurse on your ward and they should arrange this for you.



I hereby declare that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the word of God. This Sunday of the Word of God will thus be a fitting part of that

time of the year when we are encouraged to strengthen our bonds with the Jewish people and to pray for Christian unity. This is more than a temporal coincidence: the celebration of the Sunday of the Word of God has ecumenical value, since the Scriptures point out, for those who listen, the path to authentic and firm unity.

The various communities will find their own ways to mark this Sunday with a certain solemnity. It is important, however, that in the Eucharistic celebration the sacred text be enthroned, in order to focus the attention of the assembly on the normative value of God's word.
