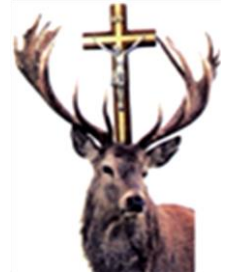

The second is through the toilet corridor and conference room. If we need to evacuate, please do not leave the site, but gather on the grass lawn at the side of the church.

There will be an opportunity to visit a special historical exhibition which will also include guest speakers. Booking is essential and the day will finish at 4pm.
