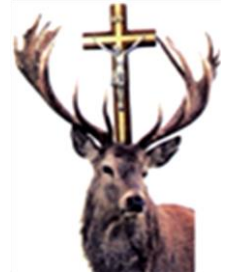

Corpus Christi Procession - this Sunday 19th June there will be a procession from St Michaels on Moor Street leaving at 2pm and arriving at the cathedral around 2.30 pm, followed by a small service with Benediction.

In Case of Emergency: please make sure you are aware of the fire escape routes. One is located at the main entrance door that you will have come entered the church by. The second is through the toilet corridor and conference room. If we need to evacuate, please do not leave the site, but gather on the grass lawn at the side of the church.

Going into Hospital: It is important that you notify the parish or ask to be referred to the relevant catholic chaplain, if you or a member of your family are admitted into hospital, if you would like a chaplain to visit, not all hospitals, ask your religion when you are admitted and not all hospitals give lists of Catholic patients to chaplains.

Sacrament of Reconciliation - is available every Saturday immediately after 10 am mass, and from 5.30 pm during the rosary, before mass and by appointment with Fr Roger.

Security: Please ensure that you take care of your own property (handbags, phones etc.) Always, while at the church.

Parish Census: If you would like to fill in a census form you will find them at the back of the church, they need to be handed to Ann Williams, our safeguarding officer, to comply with the general data protection rules (GDPR).
