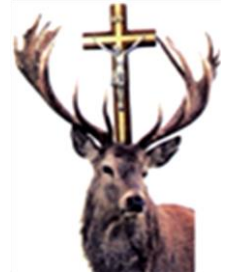

Going into Hospital: It is important that you notify the parish or ask to be referred to the relevant catholic chaplain, if you or a member of your family are admitted into hospital, if you would like a chaplain to visit, not all hospitals, ask your religion when you are admitted and not all hospitals give lists of Catholic patients to chaplains.

Sacrament of Reconciliation - is available every Saturday immediately after 10 am mass, and from 5.30 pm during the rosary, before mass and by appointment with Fr Roger.

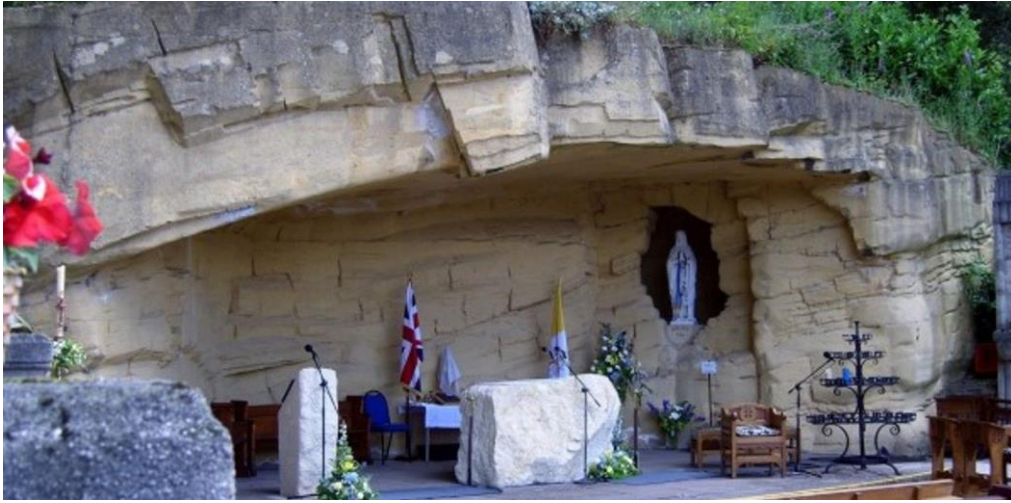
