Relics of St Bernadette Final Opportunities to venerate her relics The Relics will arrive at the Diocesan shrine of Our Lady at Hednesford at 9:00pm this Saturday 8th October. Veneration will continue until 12 midnight. On Sunday 9th at 7:00pm they will depart from Hednesford for Bicester, arriving at the parish of the Immaculate Conception, Bicester, at 9:00pm for veneration until midnight. The relics will again be available for veneration from 7asm at Bicester and will depart from Bicester at 2:00pm on Monday 10th October. Attendance is free but you are requested to register online. If you do not have access to the internet then perhaps a family member might be able to assist you with this - and might also be available to come with you.

Parish Visitations: The Parishes of our deanery (we are now in the deanery of St Chad's Cathedral and Birmingham South) are due for a visitation by the bishop (either by Archbishop Bernard or our assistant bishop David Evans). This will take place this Wednesday 12th October at 7:00pm at the Birmingham Oratory. Priests, deacons and **parishioners** from all Deanery parishes are invited to attend.
