### **A New OutReach Proposal for St Hubert's**

There are sign-up sheets at the back of the church for anyone of thinking of volunteering to help out with this new outreach initiatives who. There are also volunteer forms to fill in.

The great attraction of this project for St Hubert's is its location. In particular the "Warm Welcome" initiative is something that I feel that we as a parish would be able to support with volunteer helpers. For example, if we could commit to covering one of the three days then we could make that day a "St Hubert's helpers" day. Please see accompanying sheet for more information.

**In Case of Emergency:** please make sure you are aware of the fire escape routes. Instructions with a map / diagram are located at various points. In the case of an evacuation please gather on the grass lawn at the side of the church.

**Parish Census:** Census forms are available at the back of the church, they need to be handed to Ann Williams, our safeguarding officer, to comply with the general data protection rules (GDPR).

**Deceased priests of St Hubert's** - The deanery is in the process of compiling a list of deceased clergy's names for each parish. We

are aware of Fr Paul Orchard and ask that any other names, you may be aware of, be forwarded to us for inclusion.

**Blessing of graves** - The traditional blessing of graves services will soon be upon us. The dates for each of our local cemeteries are 6<sup>th</sup> November at Quinton, 13<sup>th</sup> November at Lodge Hill, 27<sup>th</sup> November at Thimblemill and Uplands. All services start at 2 pm.

**1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion preparation** - for all year 3 children (or above), who are to receive their 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion this summer. Every first Saturday we will be following a monthly preparation course starting on the 3<sup>rd</sup> December. Anyone interested, not at the school, please let us know.

**Next Sunday** there is the annual second collection for the Johnson Association. This is the charitable trust that cares for the sick and retired priests of the diocese. Not having a normal salary or usually the opportunity to have their own home on retirement this fund provides grants to priests of this diocese to help them to live adequately. There are envelopes at the back of church for those who can Gift Aid, and information leaflets including how to leave a legacy.
