The Brandhall Community Hub was successful in securing a grant for the *Warm Welcome* initiative. With this grant secured the hub are hoping to have the first session as soon as possible.

As you know, I am very keen for us as a parish to support this initiative in any way we can. If you would be interested in volunteering to help host this *Warm Welcome* please do sign the sign-up sheet at the back of church and fill in the available form. As I understand it the warm welcome sessions will be from 10am to 4pm Monday, Wednesday and Friday but this may be open to review. My thinking was that if we could have three pairs of people committing to a 2 hour slot per week we as a parish could perhaps cover one of the three days.

For those who would like to help out there will be an induction morning at the Hub (formerly the Coffee Shop and Paul & Barneys - 151 Castle Rd West, B68 OEL) **this Wednesday, 16th November at 10am**. I imagine this induction would last from between 1 and 2 hours.
