Advent Confessions: There is no Advent Reconciliation Service here at St Hubert's but personal confession is available here either by appointment or AFTER EVERY WEEKDAY MASS. As well as this there will be an hour-long slot this Tuesday evening from 6pm - 7pm and during the Friday evening holy hour from 6pm-6:45pm (you just need to tap Fr Roger, who will be adoring the blessed sacrament, on the shoulder to let him know). Both will be in the conference room. Advent reconciliation services and personal confessions are also available at nearby parishes - just check their websites or phone/email them for more information .

Weekday Masses: will generally be held in the Conference Room over the winter months
