could be for you.

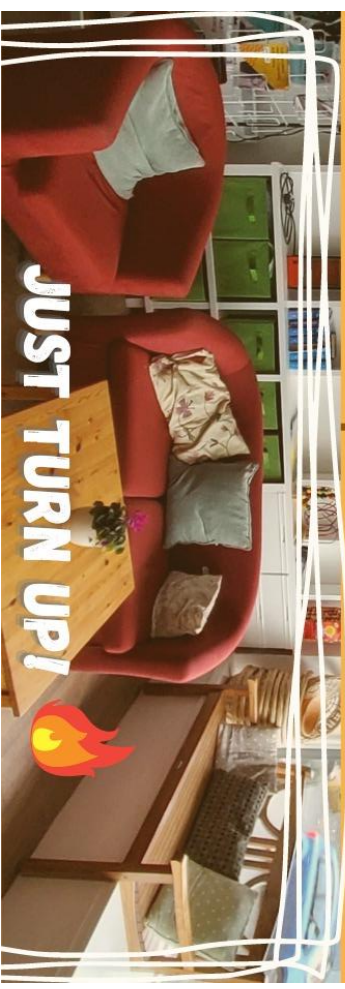
A warm space is a free, warm,
