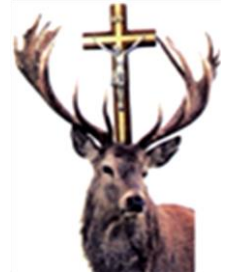

Remembrance Lilies or Yellow Roses: Once again, this year, you have a choice between lilies and yellow roses. What it is not is 'preachy' or a prayer group - if you are semi-detached from or even no longer associated with The Church, you are more than welcome; I am not out to convert anyone, just provide somewhere to talk, listen and share. I will begin and end in prayer to centre ourselves and bring the community together but you do not have to join in if you are uncomfortable. All conversations will be treated in the strictest confidence. If you or anyone you know is Roman Catholic and either diagnosed as non-neurotypical or think that you/they may be please think about coming.
