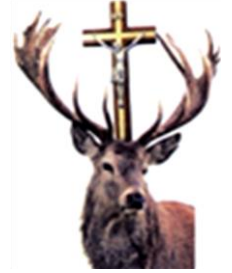

Everyone is really welcome, even if you haven't managed to join us during the vigil.

First Holy Communion Preparation - for all year 3 children (or above), who are to receive their First Holy Communion this summer. The last session is on Saturday, 6th May at 10:30am

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will be recommissioned during the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday 7th April (after the homily). Anyone who was previously appointed as an extraordinary minister for this parish is invited to come forward to be recommissioned. This ministry is "by appointment" only but if you would like to become a Eucharistic Minister, and are a regular Sunday mass attendee, please let myself or Deacon David know and we will give you due consideration.
