Sacramental preparation for young people not at catholic schools
- This is an advance notice for parents of children who are at the age when, if they were attending a Catholic school, they would be

being prepared for the sacraments of initiation - which is to say First Holy Communion for year 3 children or above and year 6 or above (or possibly year 5) for Confirmation. If this applies to you please let us know. Previously our First Holy Communion instruction has taken place in the church conference room on Saturday mornings at 10:30am (and lasting about an hour).
