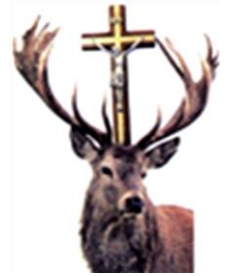

Please pray for the Repose of the Soul of Father Peter Leo Blundell, retired priest of the Archdiocese, who died at the age of 81, in Good Hope Hospital, Sutton Coldfield, on Saturday 24th August, 2024, fortified by the rites of Holy Mother Church. Fr Peter was ordained on 30th March, 1978, and through his ministry served in Handsworth, Stourbridge, Kidsgrove, Worcester, Abbey Hulton and Warley. He was also chaplain at Newman University, Birmingham, from 2012 to 2015. On his retirement in 2016 he moved to St Joseph's Home, where he continued to serve as Chaplain. We pray for Father Peter's family, his friends, his former parishioners and all who mourn him. May he Rest in Peace.

Catechesis for the coming year.

This Tuesday 8th October at 7:00pm in the conference room we will be beginning our programme for adults interested in learning more about the faith and/or may be considering becoming a Catholic. These evenings are also open to anyone who may be looking at growing in faith.

In November we will be starting, on the first Saturday of the month, at 10.30 am, teaching children from year 3 or above not in Catholic schools, in preparation for 1st Holy Communion (6 sessions)

In the new year we will be looking to start our catechesis for young people (Yr 6) who are not in Catholic schools (4 sessions) for confirmation which will take place on the 10th of July 2025.

The New Lectionaries. As from the First Sunday of Advent this year we are required to move to the new sanctioned edition of the lectionary. If you own a Sunday Missal you might want to consider getting a copy of the new edition. These can be ordered through our piety store. It also

means that the Parish must purchase a new set of lectionaries - and they are not cheap! I am, therefore, proposing that if anyone would be willing to sponsor the purchase of any one of the books we would insert a dedication of your choice into it. Study edition of the Lectionary (4 book set) £60 each book.
