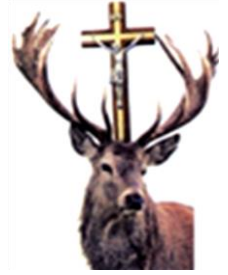

**An urgent message from Bishop Swarbrick: Sudan a humanitarian catastrophe that can no longer be ignored.** It is over 500 days since the start of the civil war in Sudan. The war has escalated, particularly in the cities of El Fasher and Khartoum, where residents face the threat of shelling, starvation, and violence. Approximately 150,000 people have died in the fighting, and more than 10 million have fled their homes. Aid agencies are struggling to deliver the food that is urgently needed to prevent mass starvation.
