Remembrance Lilies or Yellow Roses: Once again, this year, you have a choice between lilies and yellow roses. Just take a memorial card available at the back of church, write your dedication on the front of the card and write your name on the back - with either the word "Rose" or "Lily". After you have done this and made the required donation just drop your completed card in the basket available at the back of church. The cost per Lily is £1.70 each the cost per Rose is £2.00. This donation, made in memory of your loved, one helps to subsidise the cost of the church flowers at Easter and throughout the year.
