Diocesan Day Pilgrimage to Walsingham. I would like to take a group from St Huberts on a day trip to Walsingham on Saturday 10th May this year. We would aim to get to Walsingham for 11 am and depart from Walsingham for the return trip at 5pm. Please note this may mean that there may not be a Saturday evening mass available here on that day. The pick up point for the trip will be either here at St Hubert's or possibly at St Chad's Birmingham. It is difficult to know exactly how much this trip will cost until I have an idea of numbers. If you are available and interested in going on such a day trip please add your name, together with the size of your group, to the list provided at the back of the church.

Remembrance Lilies or Yellow Roses: Once again, this year, you have a choice between lilies and yellow roses. Either a lily or a rose, 'named' in memory of a loved one, will be placed in front of the altar, over the Easter festivities. Just take a memorial card available at the back of church, write your dedication on the front of the card and write your name on the back - with either the word "Rose" or "Lily". After you have done this and made the required donation just drop your completed card in the basket available at the back of church. The cost per Lily is £1.70 each the cost per Rose is £2.00. This donation, made in memory of your loved, one helps to subsidise the cost of the church flowers at Easter and throughout the year.
