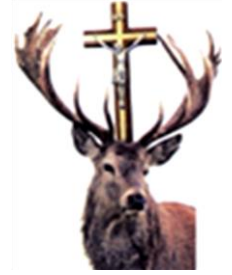

Message from the Organisation Right to Life: "MPs voted by 314 votes to 291 in support of Kim Leadbeater's assisted suicide Bill. This is a reduced majority of 23, down from the 55-vote majority the Bill had at Second Reading. The Bill now proceeds on to the House of Lords. AlThe Bill leaves the Commons lacking a majority, with fewer than half of all MPs voting for it at its final stage. The Bill still faces an uphill battle to reach Royal Assent. We will be fighting it at every stage in the House of Lords. A large number of MPs from across the political spectrum came together to give powerful speeches against the Bill during the debate today. They made it clear that this dangerous and extreme change to our laws would put the vulnerable at risk and see the ending of many lives through assisted suicide." The fight continues.
