Diocesan Pilgrimage to Harvington Hall is on Sunday 7th September. All are welcome to attend. You will, however, have to arrange your own transportation. The principal celebrant this year will be Archbishop Bernard Longley. The event begins at 1pm and finishes at 5pm. Confessions

will be available from 1:45pm to 2:30pm. Mass will be celebrated at 3pm. FREE PARKING is available on site. Free timed tours of Harvington Hall are available to pilgrims on the day and can be booked at the table in the Hall's courtyard upon arrival. **It is essential that you bring your own chairs and packed lunch.**
