Just take a memorial card available at the back of church, write your dedication on the front of the card and write your name on the back - with either the word "Rose" or "Lily". After you have done this just drop your completed card, along with the required donation, into the basket available at the back of church. The cost per Lily is £1.70 and the cost per Rose is £2.00. This donation, made in memory of your loved, one(s) helps to subsidise the cost of the church flowers at Easter and throughout the year.
