Novena to the Holy Spirit

Friday after Ascension Thursday - Saturday, the Vigil of Pentecost

This is the prototype of all novenas. It commemorates the nine days between the Ascension of Our Lord and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost when Our Lady and the twelve Apostles prayed in the upper room

Bishop Bernard Longley invites us to join him in saying a Novena to the Holy Spirit and offers up a prayer for you to say - available on the diocesan website - www.birminghamdiocese.org.uk/celebrating-pentecost

Copies of an alternative Novena to the Holy Spirit are also available at the back of church - please take one.

Although officially the first day of the Novena was on Friday you can always begin the Novena today and finish it either on Pentecost Sunday itself or on the Monday after Pentecost.
